**PURPOSE:**

To consider accepting supplemental funding in the amount of \$18,900.00 from the Criminal Justice Coordinating Council (CJCC) for DeKalb County Superior Court Drug Court treatment services and appropriating it in an existing award.

**NEED/IMPACT:**

CJCC is awarding DeKalb County Superior Court Drug Court a supplemental fund in the amount of \$18,900.00 to be used for psychiatric services, treatment services, and medications for participants. The grant period is from July 1, 2018 through June 30, 2019. Match of \$2,100 is required and will be met through Superior Court Operating and DATE Fund Budget.

**FISCAL IMPACT:**

Total supplemental funding provided by CJCC is \$18,900. Funding must be spent by June 30<sup>th</sup>, 2019, end of State FY 2019. Upon approval, funds will be appropriated into existing CJCC Drug Court award.

**RECOMMENDATION:**

To approve the resolution and authorize the chief executive officer to execute all necessary documents. To accept supplemental funding in the amount of \$18,900 from CJCC for DeKalb County Superior Court Drug Court and appropriate into an existing award;
