**PURPOSE:**

To consider accepting \$62,008.00 for the DeKalb County Veterans Court from the Criminal Justice Coordinating Council and appropriating the amount to a new Grant Fund.

**NEED/IMPACT:**

The Criminal Justice Coordinating Council has awarded \$62,008.00 to the DeKalb County Veterans Court to use towards staff training, psychiatric & nursing services, counseling services, housing, medication, drug testing & monitoring supplies, and transportation costs for program participants. The grant period is from July 1, 2020 through June 30, 2021. The required cash match (\$6,890) will be met through the Superior Court Operating and DATE Fund budget.

**FISCAL IMPACT:**

Funding for all services provided by Criminal Justice Coordinating Council Grant in the amount of \$62,008.00.

Funding has to be spent by June 30<sup>th</sup> 2021, end of State FY 2021.

**RECOMMENDATION:**

To approve the resolution and authorize the chief executive officer to execute all necessary documents. To accept \$62,008.00 for DeKalb County Veterans Court from the Criminal Justice Coordinating Council and appropriate the amount to a new Grant Fund.
