To approve the DeKalb County 2019-2023 Consolidated Plan including the 2019 Annual Action Plan to the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD); authorize the Chief Executive Officer to execute all necessary Grant Agreements in the approved by HUD; authorize payment to the Emergency Solutions Grant providers as approved in the Consolidated Plan; authorize the acceptance and appropriation of program income from any sources that may be received which exceeds the projected amounts as indicated; authorize the Chief Executive Officer to appropriated funds to the Grant Fund; authorize amendment to the prior year Consolidated Plan and Annual Action Plan to add any approved projects and cancel projects that are no longer feasible or needed; and authorize the transfer of funds from the set-aside fund on an as needed basis to cover any approved listed projects.
