Appropriate \$2,504.43 from Coronavirus Aid, Relief and Economic Security (CARES) Act funding assigned to Grant Fund #258, reserved for District 2 to the Central DeKalb Senior Center for items and supplies related to safe interaction and any other essential needs to address hardships for seniors created by the impact of the COVID-19 Pandemic.

NEED/IMPACT:
