**SUBJECT:**

**Commission District(s):** 5 and 7

Acceptance of Additional GDOT Funds up to \$4,400,000 for Lithonia Industrial Boulevard from I-20 to Woodrow Road; Cost to the County \$1.35 million.

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**PURPOSE:**

To consider accepting and appropriating up to \$4,400,000.00 from the Georgia Department of Transportation (GDOT) into a new CIP project for utility relocations and construction for the extension of Lithonia Industrial Boulevard from I-20 to Woodrow Road; and

To consider authorizing the Chief Executive Officer to execute all necessary documents for completion of the project.

**NEED/IMPACT:**

GDOT is funding 80 percent of the utility relocation and construction cost for this project. The Board of Commissioners previously approved accepting GDOT right-of-way funding for this project on April 12, 2011 and October 27, 2015. Bid opening for this project was on January 17, 2017.

**FISCAL IMPACT:**

The majority of the county match is being provided by existing HOST funds for the project. The remainder is proposed to come from 2017 CIP funds.

**RECOMMENDATION:**

To accept and appropriate up to \$4,400,000.00 from the Georgia Department of Transportation (GDOT) into a new CIP project for utility relocations and construction for the extension of Lithonia Industrial Boulevard from I-20 to Woodrow Road; and

To authorize the Chief Executive Officer to execute all necessary documents for completion of the project.
