On December 12, 2023, the BOC approved Change Order No. 2 for an amount not to exceed \$1,001,189.12. This contract consists of utilizing the competitively let SWC for the purchase of thirty-six (36) months of MS Azure SCE service credits to operate the County's business systems and data storage. This request is to increase contract funds as the County continues to increase the annual utilization of MS Azure services including system backups, video storage, managed database instances, and business applications.
