**PURPOSE:**

- To consider approving Georgia Public Safety Training Center (GPSTC) use of DeKalb County's locations, nomenclature, and/or symbols; and
- To consider approving Georgia Public Safety Training Center (GPSTC) access to Officer Cochran, DeKalb County Police Department, to participate in the development of an in-service training film; and
- To consider authorizing the Chief Executive Officer to execute the necessary documents.

**NEED/IMPACT:**

The Georgia Public Safety Training Center (GPSTC) is "the state's premier training facility for all state and local public safety-related units of government including police officers, firefighters, 911 operators, coroners, emergency management officers, rescue officers, jail officers and other emergency service personnel."

The Georgia Public Safety Training Center (GPSTC) is developing an in-service training film to assist first responders with hearing impaired citizens. The training video will feature Officer Cochran. The filming may also include law enforcement's responses to hearing impaired victims, witnesses, or perpetrators. Photographing, filming, and scene recording may include various locations throughout the County, to include the DeKalb County Police Department headquarters, precincts, symbols, and/or nomenclature.
