To approve the appropriation of \$230,000.00 from Coronavirus Aid, Relief and Economic Security (CARES) Act grant funds assigned to Account 105424.63258.E.1.01.602313 reserved for District 1 to the Center for Pan Asian Community Service for the purpose of providing support and relief from the ongoing public health emergency by administering a food pantry and a rent assistance program.
