PURPOSE:

To appropriate District 7 reserves for the establishment of a youth farm for youth who reside in DeKalb County.

NEED/IMPACT:

The \$75,500 appropriation to the Recreation, Parks, and Cultural Affairs Department will be used to establish a farm for youth in DeKalb County, which includes the cost of land restoration, cost for repair and renovation of building structure(s), purchase and installation of a professional greenhouse, cost to purchase and install an industrial honey bee farm, and cost to purchase and erect a roadside historic marker. Youth participants will learn farming and food cultivation, receive entrepreneurial training, as well as develop holistic life skills.
