PURPOSE:

To consider approving an intergovernmental agreement between the County and Gwinnett County for Gwinnett County to provide water and sewer services at 4600 Northeast Expressway, also known as 6945 Button Gwinnett Drive, which is located in the city of Doraville on the DeKalb County and Gwinnett County line and authorize the Chief Executive Officer to execute all necessary documents.

NEED/IMPACT:

The Intergovernmental Agreement outlines the terms of agreement whereby Gwinnett County will provide water and sewer services at 4600 NE Expressway, Doraville, Georgia, also known as 6945 Button Gwinnett Drive.
