PURPOSE:

To authorize the reallocation of \$108,000.00 existing Bond funds deposit in account 105384.80351.541301.01.602302 to complete the installation of electrical vehicle charging stations for 178 Sams Street Facility.

NEED/IMPACT:

In December 2018, the proceeds (approximately \$11,935,925.77) from the Clark Harrison Building sale were reallocated to reimburse the County for the purchase of certain vehicles and were restricted to a capital account for approved capital projects by the Board of Commissioners. This action relocates \$108,000.00 of the Funds in such capital account to the 178 Sams Street renovation of Buildings 1 and 2 for installation of electric vehicle (EV) charging stations.

FISCAL IMPACT:

NONE.

RECOMMENDATION:

Approve the reallocation of \$108,000.00 of the funds in the restricted capital account (which funds were originally received from the sale of the Clark Harrison Building) to 178 Sams Street renovation of Buildings 1 and 2 for occupancy by several County Departments. Authorize the Chief Executive Officer or designee to execute any necessary documents.
