#### **PURPOSE:**

Summer Grant in the amount of \$200,000 to be used by the Recreation Division within the Recreation, Parks and Cultural Affairs Department.

## **NEED/IMPACT:**

Georgia Department of Education provides funds to the Georgia Recreation and Park Association (GRPA) to establish the Building Opportunities for Out-of-School Time (BOOST) Grant Program for GRPA programs. This grant will assist the RCPA department in establishing a comprehensive summer program that seeks to leverage out-of-school and whole child support to address the learning loss that occurs during the summer months.
