**PURPOSE:**

To consider accepting \$106,467.00 for the DeKalb County Felony Mental Health Court from the Criminal Justice Coordinating Council and appropriating the amount to a new Grant Fund.

**NEED/IMPACT:**

The Criminal Justice Coordinating Council has awarded \$106,467.00 to the DeKalb County Felony Mental Health Court. Funding will be used toward annual conference, psychiatric & nursing services, counseling services, peer support, drug testing & monitoring supplies for program participants. In addition to salary & benefits for the Program Coordinator. The grant period is from July 1, 2022 through June 30, 2023. The required cash match (\$14,518.00) will be met through the Superior Court Operating budget.

**FISCAL IMPACT:**

Funding for all services provided by Criminal Justice Coordinating Council Grant in the amount of \$106,467.00. Funding must be spent by June 30, 2023, end of State FY 2023.

**RECOMMENDATION:**

To approve the resolution and authorize the chief executive officer to execute all necessary documents. To accept \$106,467.00 for DeKalb County Felony Mental Health Court from the Criminal Justice Coordinating Council and appropriate the amount to a new Grant Fund
