This contract consists of providing tiered assessment and cleaning to gravity sewer mains and manholes, assessment of sanitary stream encroachment, location and height adjustment of manholes and replacement of vented manhole covers. This request is to increase the scope of work and funding. Awarded to EnviroWaste Services Group, Inc. Amount Not To Exceed \$1,586,400.00.

## PURPOSE:

Awarded by the BOC on December 17, 2019 for an amount not to exceed \$2,654,950.00. This contract consists of providing tiered assessments of the sanitary sewer system's manholes and small diameter pipes utilizing CCTV and acoustic inspections and smoke and dye testing; cleaning; as well as locating, adjusting, and replacement of manholes and covers. This request, to increase the scope of work through assistance with flow monitoring services; pre-CCTV inspection; and allowance replenishment, will allow the contractor to assist DWM in unforeseen critical services as well continue in providing existing sanitary sewer system tiered assessments.
