PURPOSE:

Be Someone, Inc. is a DeKalb County-based youth development organization that has been effectively conducting programs nation-wide since 2000. It exits to reduce the acceleration of crime and violence and eradicate the school to prison pipeline teaching essential life skills to youth through the principles taught by learning the game of chess by using the principles of the game of chess to teach invaluable life skills as part of the process of learning to be skilled positive decision makers. NEED/IMPACT:

Our DeKalb County youth are facing unprecedented challenges that test their decision-making abilities every day. COVID has exasperated many of these issues and crime is rampant. Sadly, we see weekly, too many of our youth making the wrong choices and these choices effect households, property, businesses, and visitors throughout DeKalb County. It is imperative to collaborate with as many organizations as possible since the more young people that we can reach, the greater the odds of positive outcomes will be for us all.
